#### **CHARLESTON BATTERY'S BEN PIRMANN REACHES CENTURY MARK IN VICTORIES**

The Charleston Battery's **Ben Pirmann** recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> coaching victory in the USL Championship across the regular season and playoffs on Saturday afternoon as the Battery took a 2-0 victory against Louisville City FC at Lynn Family Stadium.

The 40-year-old was the sixth individual to reach the century mark in the USL Championship era and the second-youngest to reach the mark. Pirmann also reached the mark in the second-fewest games in league history, second to only former Louisville City FC Head Coach **Danny Cruz**.

### **INDY ELEVEN'S JACK BLAKE EQUALS CLUB'S ALL-TIME GOALSCORING MARK**

Indy Eleven's **Jack Blake** recorded his first goal of the 2026 regular season on Saturday night against Pittsburgh Riverhounds SC. In turn, the English midfielder equaled the club's all-time goalscoring lead with 27 goals across all competitions since joining the Boys in Blue prior to the 2023 season.

Blake has recorded 24 goals in 88 regular season appearances for Indy, also the most for the club in the USL Championship since the team joined the league prior to the 2018 season. Only three players have recorded more than 50 regular season goals for a single club in the USL Championship's regular season in Louisville City's **Cameron Lancaster** (76), the Tampa Bay Rowdies' **Sebastian Guenzatti** (59) and Sacramento Republic FC's **Cameron Iwasa** (57).

### **CHARLESTON BATTERY RECORD CLUB-FIRSTS WITH VICTORY IN LOUISVILLE**

The **Charleston Battery** recorded multiple club-firsts with its 2-0 victory against **Louisville City FC** on Saturday evening at Lynn Family Stadium, claiming its first road win against LouCity in club history at the 12<sup>th</sup> attempt while also recording the club's fewest shots in a win on record in the USL Championship era.

Charleston recorded two goals on three shots against Louisville to earn all three points, becoming the 15<sup>th</sup> team to record a victory while taking three or fewer shots since the start of the 2017 season. Only one club claimed victory while taking only one official shot in a contest over that timespan when **Rio Grande Valley FC** earned a 1-0 win away at **Colorado Springs Switchbacks FC** on July 1, 2017 as **Ruben Luna's** penalty kick proved the difference while the Switchbacks held a 15-1 advantage in total shots.

### *Quick Hits*

- Birmingham Legion FC forward **Romario Williams** became the 26<sup>th</sup> player to reach 80 goal contributions in the USL Championship's regular season with his assist on **Tyler Pasher**'s second goal against Loudoun United FC. The Jamaican has recorded 67 goals and 13 assists in 176 regular season appearances.

- Tampa Bay Rowdies forward **Evan Conway** has recorded a goal contribution in six consecutive games dating back to the 2025 regular season. Conway recorded a goal in each of his final three appearances for North Carolina FC before notching two goals and one assist in his first three regular season games for Tampa Bay.

- Sacramento Republic FC midfielder **Blake Willey** became the club's fifth-youngest goalscorer in USL Championship play as he bagged his first professional goal aged 18 years, 341 days old against Phoenix Rising FC. Former Republic FC player **Rafael Jarugui** is the youngest regular-season goalscorer in club history, having scored his first goal against the LA Galaxy II aged 17 years, 180 days old on June 18, 2022.

- Birmingham Legion FC forward **Tyler Pasher** recorded his 40<sup>th</sup> and 41<sup>st</sup> goals in the USL Championship regular season against Loudoun United FC on Saturday evening. The Canadian is the 29<sup>th</sup> player to reach 40 goals and 20 assists in the USL Championship regular season all-time.

- El Paso Locomotive FC forward **Amando Moreno** reached 20 regular season goals for the club with his two-goal performance on Saturday night against Las Vegas Lights FC. Moreno joins **Luis Solignac** (35 goals) and **Josué Aaron Gómez** (32 goals) in reaching the mark for the club.

- El Paso Locomotive FC forward **Amando Moreno** has recorded six goals and one assist in seven career appearances against Las Vegas Lights FC in his career following his brace on Saturday night at Southwest University Park.

- Las Vegas Lights FC's **Johnny Rodriguez** and the Tampa Bay Rowdies' **Evan Conway** became the 79<sup>th</sup> and 80<sup>th</sup> players to reach 50 goal contributions in the USL Championship regular season, with Conway reaching the mark in his 116<sup>th</sup> appearance and Rodriguez in his 137<sup>th</sup> appearance in the league.

- **San Antonio FC**'s current six-game undefeated streak dating to the final game of the 2025 regular season is the club's longest since a seven-game undefeated streak between July 30-Aug. 31, 2023.

- **El Paso Locomotive FC**'s current three-game winning streak is the club's longest since it recorded a seven-game winning streak between April 9-June 4, 2023.

- **San Antonio FC** has an active 396-minute shutout streak dating to the opening game of the regular season. The club's run of four consecutive clean sheets is its longest since a four-shutout streak between July 2-27, 2022.
